Objectives of this role

Reporting directly to the Chief Commercial Officer, the Investment Associate & Due Diligence Lead is integral to the success of project development. The Investment Associate & Due Diligence Lead will provide initial project budgeting, analysis, and modeling, as well as ongoing monitoring market conditions which may impact project stability.

Duties and responsibilities

- Develop and maintain complex financial models for specific projects in collaboration with project developers;
- Conduct financial analysis and modelling to identify trends and support investment decisions, including presentation of project performance against key financial metrics;
- Collaborate with cross-functional teams, including sustainability, finance, legal, and operations, to ensure accurate and timely financial modelling analysis and results.
- Deliver ongoing financial results and analysis to stakeholders, including senior management and investors.
- Monitor and assess the impact of changes in (carbon and other) market conditions and economic factors on financial performance.
- Carry out fundamental market analysis and assist maintaining IGP's inhouse carbon pricing curves;
- Be responsible for conducting the project due diligence and risk assessment process as well as development of investor data room materials.
